Announcements:

The following is being published so everyone knows what is covered by the cleaning contract.

- Parish Center:** weekly clean the men's and women's restrooms in the basement. Hall area will be vacuumed and the stair rails sanitized.
- Parish Center** 2nd and 4th week, vacuum carpeted areas. sweep and mop tile areas, chairs and tables will be wiped off, back entry to the kitchen will be swept and mopped, sanitize all door knobs, sweep all stairs. **This does not include the kitchen or serving island.**
- Conference room and office**—weekly: dust, vacuum or mop conference room and office. Empty the trash. April and September Clean windows in side entry, conference room and office if needed. Church/Rectory Area: weekly; dust, sweep, and mop the area between the Church and the Rectory. Vacuum stairs and landing.
- Classrooms:** vacuum, dust and empty trash from each classroom. (Prefer this be done Feb., April, July, & Nov.)
- Rectory:** will be cleaned the 1st and 3rd weeks of each month at the discretion of the Priest.
- Additional cleaning projects may be requested by the Priest. Time and cost will be negotiated at the time of the request.**
